COVID-19 RETURN TO PLAY PROTOCOLS

MASKS are **MANDATORY** for **EVERYONE** to enter the facility
SIGN IN/OUT is **MANDATORY** for **EVERYONE** upon entry to facility
SANITIZING is **MANDATORY** for **EVERYONE** upon entry to facility
PRESCREENING is **MANDATORY** for **EVERYONE** upon entry to facility.
Please use the Province of Manitoba prescreening tool.

IF YOU FEEL ILL OR ARE SHOWING COVID-19 SYMPTOMS YOU MUST NOT ENTER THE FACILITY.



- ✓ Physical distancing of 2m (6ft) between you and others is required at all times. Please respect distance markings/signage.
- ✓ Maximum of 115 spectators allowed in facility at any one time. Not including players or coaches.
- ✓ Avoid congregating in small or large groups anywhere in the facility.
- ✓ Hand sanitizer is located throughout the facility for everyone to use.
- ✓ Teams will be assigned to a dressing room – they must use that room and not switch.
- ✓ No off-ice warm-ups will be performed inside the facility.
- ✓ Spectators will exit the facility with participants 30 minutes of completion of ice time
- ✓ Cleaning will be performed when participants vacate the dressing room/bench etc prior to the next group being allowed use of that area.
- ✓ User groups affiliated with other organizations (ie Hockey Manitoba, Skate Canada) must follow those rules as well as BDCC rules – if they differ, they must follow the strictest rules.

BDCC and or Prairie View Municipality are not responsible for any fines incurred by users or spectators for not following the Manitoba Health Restoring Safe Services guidelines/public orders as well as the Return to Play guidelines provided by the User Group's provincial sport body (if applicable).
