

J & G Homes Arena has established the following rules to ensure the health and safety of our guests and staff. We are incorporating this Return to Play Protocol that will continue to enhance the guest experience and ensure safe participation in our facility. The health and safety of our employees and guests is our top priority.

All users must adhere to any applicable Provincial Public Health Orders and J & G Homes Arena protocols. Deviation from the public health order of facility protocols may result in the group being asked to leave the facility immediately and future ice rental privileges could be suspended indefinitely.

VACCINATIONS: Public access into the facility/arenas is restricted to the following:

a) Persons who produce proof that they are fully immunized;

b) Persons who produce proof of a Government issued medical exemption to not receive the COVID-19 vaccine;

c) Persons aged 12-17 that meet one of the criteria listed below (Proof of Single Dose or Negative Test);

d) Persons under 12 years of age.

PROOF OF A SINGLE DOSE OF VACCINATION: A printout or web view of an individual aged between 12 and 17's government-issued immunization record as well as government-issued identification (photo not necessary) or a school ID card to verify the person's identity. A printout or web view of proof of a single dose of vaccination is available by registering on the Shared Health website at https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/test-results/.

PROOF OF A NEGATIVE TEST: For those individuals 12-17 who have not received a single dose of vaccination, proof of a negative covid-19 test taken within the 72 hours before participation which must be confirmed by a pharmacist and supported by government-issued identification or a school ID card to verify the individual's identity.

FACE COVERING: Face masks must be worn at all times by everyone who enters the facility, excluding those engaged in athletic activity. Masks are to be worn in the dressing rooms, but can be removed while on the ice. Coaches who are not engaged in athletic activity are required to wear a mask/face covering at all times, including while on the bench.

CAPACITY: All indoor group activities permitted with <u>no capacity limits</u> on participants. This includes games, practices, competitions/tournaments, and day camps.

There is no limitation on the spectator capacity. Spectators must wear a mask at all times.

HEALTH SCREENING: The responsibility of completing self assessments for player and parents will be with the teams dedicated Compliance Officer: <u>https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/</u>

Employees and guests are to stay home if they do not feel well.

HAND SANITIZER: Hand sanitizer will be available in the facility.

FACILITY MAINTENANCE & SANITIZATION: J & G Homes Arena will be thoroughly cleaning the dressing rooms following the completion of each day. Washrooms and common areas will be cleaned and sanitized on a regular basis daily.

Users are responsible for cleaning dressing room before they depart to the extent of any garbage or items brought in by the user group.

DRESSING ROOMS: There is no capacity limit in the dressing rooms. Each ice booking will be allocated two dressing rooms. Groups must allow time for staff to disinfect the dressing rooms between users where applicable.

Access to dressing room areas is limited to sixty (60) minutes before and thirty (30) minutes after your scheduled ice time. Please use only the dressing room that you have been assigned to.

Players/Coaches are required to wear a mask/face covering while in the dressing room.

Please refer to the arena dressing room assignment board for assignments.
