Proof of Vaccination

- > All adults must show proof of full vaccination and photo ID before entering.
- Youth 12 and over
 - o who are skating ARE NOT required to be vaccinated
 - who are observing ARE required to be fully vaccinated to enter

Guidelines for all facility users:

- > Wear a mask or balaclava in all areas of the arena.
- Stay home if you are experiencing symptoms, even if they are mild.
- Screen participants, staff and volunteers daily for symptoms prior to work or participation in activities. Individuals who have Covid-19 symptoms will not be permitted on site for work or scheduled activities.
- Allow physical distancing of two meters (6 ft) at all times; except brief exchanges and only when they are actively participating in a sport or activity.
- > Only conduct necessary and brief exchanges within two meters of others.
- > Avoid congregating in shared areas.
- Use of hand sanitizer when you enter and exit the facility.
- Follow guidelines from sport organizations and facility site plans to minimize physical contact and risk of Covid-19 transmission between participants.
- > All users are asked to bring their own filled water bottle.
- > All users must adhere to their Provincial Sport Association Guidelines.
- No dryland training

Flow of People and Physical Distancing

- The maximum number of people permitted indoors is 50, except where distinct groups of 50 can be separated to prevent contact with other groups through the use of separate exits, staggered schedules, as well as sufficient space to avoid congestion.
 - Maximum people on the ice for Oakville Skating Program or Oakville Minor Hockey Association = 35
 - Maximum people on the ice for other rentals = 25
 - Maximum people upstairs = 25
 - Maximum people in the stands = 50
 - Renter is responsible to ensure parents & spectators practice physical distancing
 - Maximum in dressing room 1 = 9 adults or child with a helper
 - Maximum in dressing room 2 = 9 adults or child with a helper
 - Maximum in dressing room 3 = 8 adults or child with a helper
 - Maximum in dressing room 4 = 7 adults or child with a helper
 - Maximum skaters in REF dressing room = 2
- All bookings will continue to go through the facility scheduler via email or phone. Non-contact forms of payment are appreciated.
- Covid-19 signage will be posted at the entrance of the arena and throughout the facility reminding patrons of physical distancing measures, hand hygiene and cough etiquette.

Oakville Arena – Oakville, Manitoba COVID-19 Site Plan as of September 9, 2020

- Care & Control
 - Each renter is required to maintain a list of their group members (coaches, skaters, parents and spectators) in attendance as well as contact information for 21 days to ensure appropriate public health follow-up can take place if a participant is exposed to Covid-19.
 - Each renter is responsible for the actions of their group members (coaches, skaters, parents and spectators).
 - Each renter is responsible for pre-screening the group members; ie if they have been out of the province in the last 14 days or showing symptoms of Covid-19.
 - Each renter shall encourage participants to shower at home.
 - Each renter shall encourage participants to bring their own water bottles and not to share with others.
 - Anyone displaying signs of Covid-19 are not allowed to enter the facility.
 - People who are ill should NOT participate in or be spectators of recreational activities.
- > Entrance through south doors and exit through west door.
- > Follow arrows for single direction areas.
- > Hand hygiene stations will be placed at the entrance and exit of the facility.
- > Bathrooms will be open to the public, with limited capacity. Staff will sanitize frequently.
- Staff will sanitize dressing rooms between users.
- Staff will sanitize high touch points frequently.
- Skaters will be allowed to enter dressing rooms 20 minutes prior to rental and must exit within 20 minutes after their ice time is complete. Only 1 parent/helper is allowed with the skater in the dressing room (no extra kids can go with them).
- Maximum of 2 parents/siblings/observers per skater.
- All minors not on the ice must be directly supervised at all times no running around playing downstairs or around the bleachers. Parents are encouraged not to bring children to the rink who are not actively skating.

Oakville Rink Staff / Board will monitor all users and remind of social distancing. There will be no loitering in the facility.
