

Shoal Lake Communiplex Covid-19 Protocol (Rev 1 _22/09/2021)

With the COVID-19 Pandemic and current public health orders the Shoal Lake Communiplex is implementing the following precautionary protocols and procedures to provide a safe “return to play” for all participants and staff.

General Facility Protocol

Symptoms

If a player or staff member is ill (any symptoms whatsoever) they **must not** attend the facility.

Screening

All staff members and visitors (participants, officials, spectators, etc.) must use the Province of Manitoba Online Screening Tool <https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool> to pre-screen before coming to the facility.

User Groups, Communication Officers, coaches/ contacts will be responsible to self-assess, assess and pre-screen all of their participants prior to entering the facility.

Contact tracing

Facility must keep a copy of all participants with name, phone numbers, and e-mail address for a minimum of 21 days or a full incubation period.

Vaccination Requirements

All adults (18 and up) entering the facility must present proof of vaccination and picture ID.

For ticketed events spectators 12 and up must present proof of vaccination and ID to watch the event.

Masks

All staff, volunteers, user groups, patrons and spectators entering Shoal Lake Communiplex are required to wear a mask at all time while being in the facility (which includes dressing rooms), except while eating or drinking. Coaches and staff are to wear masks on the bench.

Contact tracing

Facility must keep a copy of all participants with name, phone numbers, and e-mail address for a minimum of 21 days or a full incubation period.

Hand Sanitizing

Everyone entering and exiting the facility should use the provided hand sanitizer when they enter the facility.

Rink Access

Participants will only be able to access the facility **60** minutes prior to their allocated ice time. Please follow posted signs and social distancing requirements (2 metres/ 6 feet apart).

User Groups, Communication Officers, coaches/ contacts will be responsible to direct the participants to vacate the facility **within 30** after their allocated ice time.

All visitors must follow posted signs and social distancing requirements (2 metres/ 6 feet apart).
