Statement of Commitment

The Municipality of Souris-Glenwood is committed to ensuring the health and safety of all visitors/user groups of Souris Glenwood Memorial Complex. This document provides our Return to Play Protocol. We recognize that the COVID-19 pandemic is fluid, and it is our goal to provide you with a safe space to enjoy recreational activities while adhering to provincial/federal regulations.

All users must adhere to the most current Provincial health order and Souris Glenwood Memorial Complex protocols. Deviation from the public health order of facility protocols may result in the group being asked to leave the facility immediately and future ice rental privileges could be suspended indefinitely.

GENERAL FACILITY GUIDELINES

For individuals - Prior to entering the facility scan the bar code which will take you to Covid-19 screening questions.

Group users do not need to use the code but are required to keep their list of participants and spectators.



SGMC has implemented a number of protocols to maintain provincial standards to help prevent the spread of COVID-19. This includes, but is not limited to:

- 1. Please do not enter the facility if you are feeling unwell
- 2. All participants are required to do a self check assessment prior to entering the building
- 3. Masks are mandatory in the facility as well as in dressing rooms

- 4. All patrons and staff members must adhere to proper physical distancing guidelines.
- 5. Hand sanitization mandatory upon entry. Hand sanitizer is available throughout the facility.
- 6. User groups are asked not to arrive until 45 minutes to their booking
- 7. The complex is open to the following individuals User Groups are responsible for tracking this information for their participants/spectators
 - a. Person's who produce proof that they are fully immunized; you will need to provide proof of vaccination plus a piece of Government issued ID that identifies you. Cards to be scanned as well.
 - b. Persons who produce proof from the Government of Manitoba that there is a medical reason for the person NOT to receive a vaccine for Covid-19
 - c. Persons under 18 years of age if they are participating in the activity
- 8. Players over the age of 12 who are not actively participating and wish to spectate must provide proof of double vaccination.
- 9. Participants/Spectators under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a double vaccinated adult.
- 10. Spectators must maintain 2M distance and leave immediately following the booking.
- 11. Upon arrival players should proceed directly to your assigned dressing room, then to the ice surface.
- 12. Increased frequency of cleaning the facility (bathrooms, changerooms, high-traffic areas
- 13. All ice bookings must be made through the Manager of Parks and Recreation. Ice times are not inter-changeable. Any changes to ice times must be approved by Management.
- 14. Dressing rooms will be preselected and will be posted on the sign board.
- 15. You must leave the facility immediately following your rental.

Each group is responsible to dedicating one adult as a Compliance Officer to ensure that all facility and health department protocols are followed. This individual/s is responsible to monitor their group/ spectators during their entire time in the building. To ensure all protocols are followed. This includes ensuring teams have completed a self assessment check prior to attending the facility and enforcing all 'Return to Play' protocols.

ON-ICE PRACTICES:

All groups are required to follow public health orders and their respective Provincial Sport governing guidelines
