

ST. EUSTACHE ARENA PROTOCOL 2020-2021 SEASON

GENERAL

- MASKS MANDATORY (unless medically unable, or under the age of 2) – Players, coaches, staff, volunteers, spectators and officials will be required to wear face masks in facilities where Hockey Manitoba sanctioned events take place.
- Players and officials are not required to wear face masks while on the ice engaging in physical activity but are required to wear masks in the dressing room prior to going on the ice. Team officials, including coaches are required to wear face masks while on the bench.
- Spectators are expected to maintain social distancing, 2 metres, at all times when in the arena.
- You must be seated to remove your mask in order to eat or drink
- As per the provincial health order all participants/instructors/coaches/staff and spectators must be screened for symptoms prior to arrival and participation each day and are not allowed to participate if they are ill with COVID symptoms.
- All participants/instructors/coaches/staff and spectators are required to use Manitoba's COVID-19 screening tool before each session. Screening can be completed online at - sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/ -or- in Interactive Voice Response (IVR) format at 1-877-308-9038.

ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE

- Participants will not be able to enter until 30 minutes prior to the start of their ice time. Participants must vacate the premises within 30 minutes after their Ice time has concluded so that the rooms can be thoroughly cleaned and sanitized.
- When entering the arena one family member per group is required to sign in at the entrance table for contact tracing purposes. Player attendance is to be tracked by their team.
- Arena doors are clearly marked ENTER and EXIT.
- Please exit the facility immediately following your ice time.

ICE RENTALS and GAMES

- Your dressing room space will be sanitized prior to every use.
- All players and coaches must maintain physical distancing while in the arena, including dressing rooms, and on-ice as much as possible, excluding participants while they are actively engaged in hockey activity.
- Each team will be assigned 2 dressing rooms. Access to the dressing rooms is limited to 10 players per room, additional spaces are located on the benches outside the rooms.
- Rooms 1&2 use east staircase to access the ice, rooms 3&4 use the west stairs.
- Remain seating in your dressing room until the Zamboni has completed ice cleaning to avoid congestion.
- Dressing room showers and washrooms are permitted for use at this time.
- A Coach/Instructor must be in the dressing room with the participants at all times to ensure physical distancing protocols are being adhered to.
- Please adhere to signage when entering and exiting the ice surface
