Wawanesa & District Recreation Centre Game Day Procedures

General Guidelines:

- Participants, spectators and staff must stay home when ill and are not allowed entry if the are ill with Covid-19 symptoms
- Participants, spectators and staff must us the self-screening toll prior to arrival: https://sharedhealthmb.ca/covid19/screening-tool/
- Verification of Self-Screening will occur each day at arrival for coaches, participants and spectators.
- Masks are to be worn at all times with the exception of on-ice and facility staff

Facility:

- Entrance will be the Main entrance east doors. Exit will be main entrance west doors.
- All occupants are expected to follow traffic flow as indicated by posted directional decals.
- Occupants are expected to maintain social distance at all times. Congregation will be actively discouraged.
- All participants, spectators and team staff are expected to choose a set location and stay in that location during the entire game other than to use washroom or canteen (if available)
- Hand sanitizer will be made readily available at numerous locations throughout the facility.
- Washrooms will be clearly marked with distancing and one occupant at a time.
- Regular cleaning will occur of high touch areas as well as dressing rooms and benches after each use.

Entry:

- Participants, spectators and team staff are expected to space themselves out when entering the facility.
- All participants, spectators and team staff MUST be screened and signed in upon arrival.
- All participants, spectators and team staff MUST sanitize upon entry

Equipment:

- Water bottles and towels on the bench are not to be shared.
- All bottles should be labelled with name of owner and filled prior to arrival
- Equipment that is shared should only be handled by the owner.

Games:

- Current capacity is reduced for spectators to 1 person per player for visiting teams. Host team allowed 2 persons per player.
- Bench capacity is open to the game day roster as well as game day staff
- Players and officials bear the responsibility of maintaining distance as much as possible.
- Bench staff and time keepers must wear masks.
- Timekeepers should remind players in the penalty box to maintain distance as much as possible.
- 10-minute penalties should be served at the player's gate or in the dressing room.
- Team celebrations and post-game handshakes are actively discouraged.
- PA announcements should be made regularly during a game to remind spectators of distancing protocols.

Pre-Game Warm-up:

• Players will warm-up individually, not as a group.
